



## Student Right-To-Know Disclosures

In accordance with the federal *Student Right-to-Know Act*, and to assist you in making an informed decision about your career education, Advanced Training Institute has provided the latest Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) graduation, retention and student body diversity rates for your review. ### Annual Graduation Rate

The annual graduation rate is calculated based on a cohort of full-time, first-time, certificate-seeking students, enrolled from September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015 and for whom 150% of the normal time for program completion has elapsed as of August 31, 2017. IPEDS defines full-time as a student enrolled for 24 or more clock hours per week each term. All ATI students are enrolled for 20 clock hours per week each term, making them part-time. IPEDS does not calculate an annual graduation rate for part-time students.

### Annual Retention Rates

Annual retention rates are calculated based on the percentage of first-time certificate-seeking students enrolled from August 1, 2016 through October 31, 2016, who are still enrolled or have completed their program as of August 1, 2017. Rates are reported for both full-time and part-time students.
